## Refugee Assistance & Humanitarian Relief

**10,000** refugees received temporary shelter, meals, clothing, medicine, and spiritual care at the Seminary property in L'viv.

**7,000+** refugees received assistance and transport to safer locations in Ukraine and other nearby countries.













**35,000+** internally displaced people received food and other essential supplies.

**550,000** pounds of food and other supplies distributed to 189 cities, towns, and villages.

## WeCare Centers







**8 WeCare Centers** established to rebuild and restore the physical, emotional, and spiritual health of communities throughout Ukraine; 10 more opening/under development.

**70+ generators** of various sizes distributed to homes, shelters, and other gathering places.

Multiple teams of U.S.-based Christian counselors provided both direct counseling and "trauma helper" training.

76,000 New Testaments distributed.

15 Bible study groups and 1 new church launched in the midst of war.

2,000+ people began attending church services.



In the midst of many ongoing challenges, UBTS resumed seminary operations as multiple cohort groups of 150-200 students returned for in-person classes, often meeting in the basement of the new building which served as a bomb shelter.

493 students completed their studies and graduated.

**1,600+** total student enrollment reached.

**UBTS waived tuition costs** for students unable to pay because of the war.
