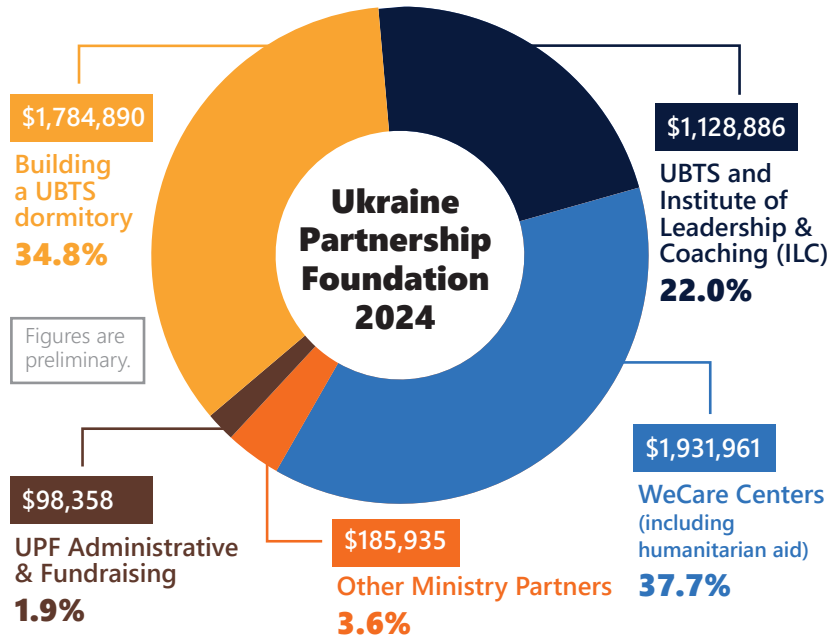


WHY THIS WORK IS SO VITAL

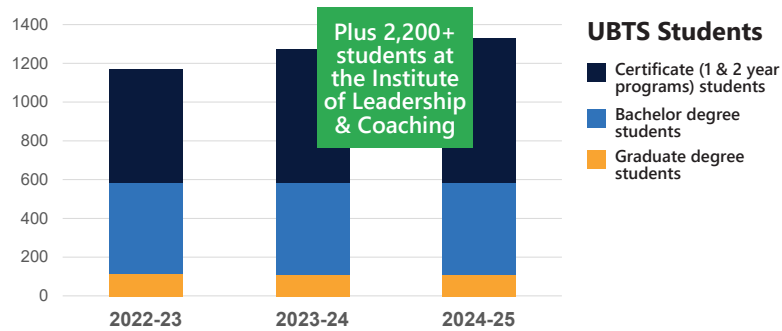

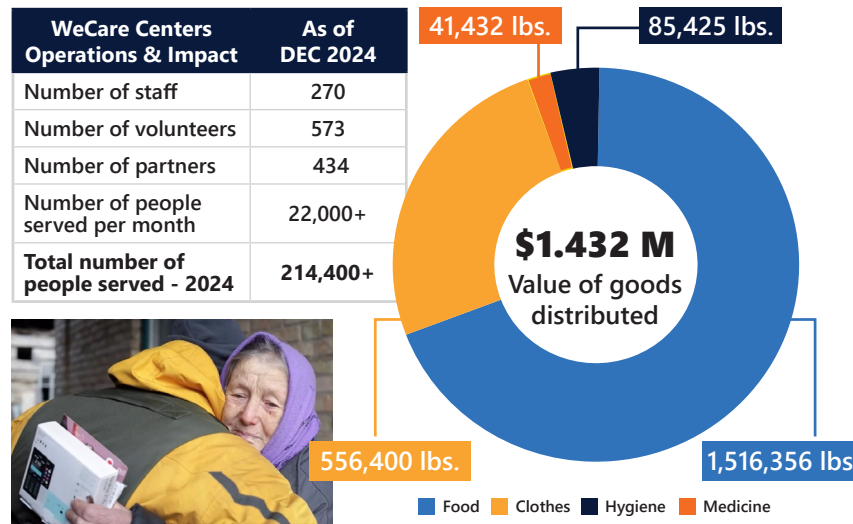
