



For three years of war, WeCare Centers have provided vital physical and spiritual services in communities throughout Ukraine, serving hundreds of thousands of internally displaced people as well as local residents. Today, these centers of help and hope are positioned to continue strengthening Ukraine by:

- **Developing Christian communities**
- **Supplying humanitarian aid**
- **Sponsoring education/training**
- **Providing trauma and spiritual counseling**
- **Creating community partnerships to promote sustainable change**

**The Mission:** to form a mature civil society in Ukraine that creates a culture of responsibility for the local community.

**The Values:** Gospel-centered relationships, human dignity, personal responsibility, and community focus.

**The What:** training, Christian counseling, partnerships/networking between churches and NGOs, humanitarian aid, developing thriving churches.

**The How:** emphasize application, innovation, measuring impact, developing networks of like-minded people and partnerships.

## **WeCare Centers Network Strategic Goals 2025-2026**

1. **Expand the WeCare network** across Ukraine from 17 to 50 Centers.
2. **Develop WeCare communities** characterized by five key features of a mature civil society:
  - i. People with a clear system of values based on the Judeo-Christian worldview
  - ii. People who have a Ukraine-centered consciousness
  - iii. People who are politically active citizens
  - iv. People who have critical thinking
  - v. People who care about the well-being of their communities
3. **Create a culture of responsibility** in WeCare Centers – requiring the highest standards in accounting, reporting, and analyzing the effectiveness of activities – in order to achieve a high level of public trust in non-governmental organizations with Christian values.
4. **Uphold WeCare Centers in the public square** as influential and trusted participants in Ukraine’s civil society who demonstrate Christian values and are committed to building and strengthening their communities.
5. **Facilitate the planting of 7-10 new churches** in Ukraine, in cooperation with Baptist Union representative Ruslan Shyringa and the UBTS Mission and New Churches program.
6. **Provide quality training for counselors of WeCare Centers** in Druzhkivka, Kharkiv, Rivne, Korosten, and Kherson through the one-year program *Fundamentals of Christian Counseling*, in partnership with the Master's program in Christian Counseling at UBTS; and create internship opportunities for Master's Degree students at WeCare Centers to ensure that people have access to professional spiritual and emotional assistance.
